Purpose of Meeting

The purpose of the meeting is to update you on the proposed project, present design alternatives, and seek your feedback.

Project Purpose

The purpose of this project is to upgrade traffic flow and congestion at the intersection of Erie Street and Monroe Street in Sylvania, Ohio. Work includes converting the intersection into a single-lane modern roundabout. To expedite construction, the roadway is proposed to be closed for 60 days with a signed detour posted in advance. Construction is estimated to begin in Spring 2027 and completed by late Fall of 2027.

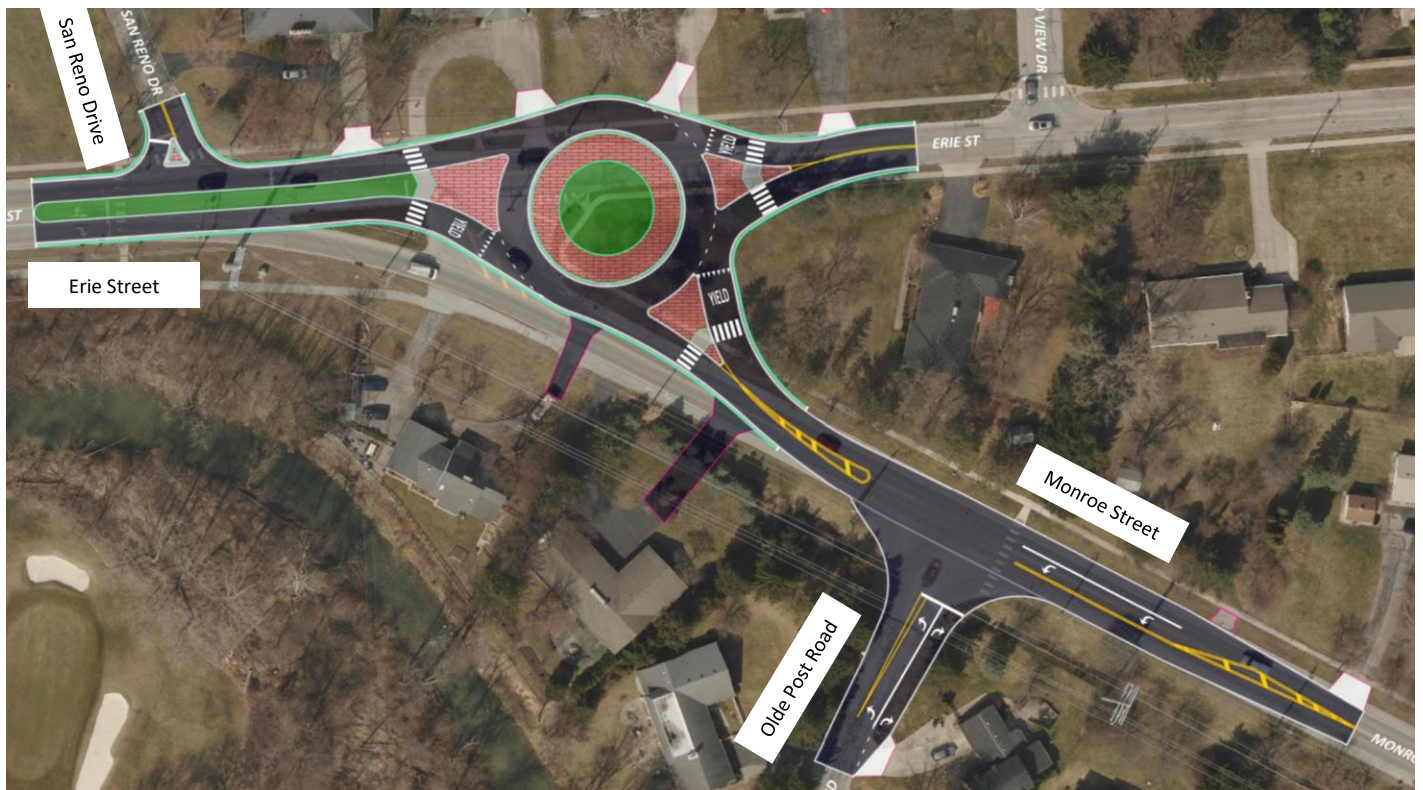
